

Regulations of the International Baccalaureate Educator Certificate Programme by National Taiwan Normal University

1. To elaborate students' educational profession and international competitiveness and to empower them in job markets, the Office of Teacher Education and Career Service (the Office) in National Taiwan Normal University (NTNU) builds up Programme of International Baccalaureate Educator Certificate (IBEC Programme).
2. IBEC Programme in NTNU includes International Education Programme (IEP) and Chinese Language Education Programme (CLEP).
3. IEP and CLEP enroll 60 and 20 students respectively. The actual numbers of recruited students can be less than the aforementioned and are subjected to change according to the number of applicants and operational needs. However, the number of students in each programme shall not exceed more than 150% of the aforementioned quota.
4. Teaching Education Programme (TEP) students in NTNU (including Special Education Program and those who have obtained TEP Certificate) or the students with primary and/or middle school teacher qualification (both including special education) are eligible to apply for IBEC programme. Each programme may have entry requirements. Further information shall refer to Student Admission Handbook.
5. IBEC Programme's application and selection takes place every Spring semester. Admission schedule and related information of the year will be announced. All applications should follow what are stated in Student Admission Handbook to submit documents.
6. The selection process is mainly based on documentary review while written or/and oral examination may be conducted as needed.
7. In addition to required credits, Students in IBEC Programme have to meet English proficiency requirement, and attend IB Teaching and Learning seminars or workshops for 15+ hours. Please refer to The Programme of International Baccalaureate Educator Certificate Curriculum and English Proficiency List for each programme's minimum credits and English proficiency requirements. Students who need credit transfer shall present programme certificate and transcripts of each semester to responsible departments for approval: Compulsory courses are to be approved by the departments organizing the courses. Selective courses can be approved by the Office of Teacher Education and Career Service or the responsible departments.
8. Students fail to receive all required credits within the years of study may continue their IBEC Programme if they attend any Graduate Institute in NTNU within 3 years after graduation. To be qualified for continuing IBEC Programme, they need to meet the requirement listed in Article 4 of the Regulations of IBEC Programme in NTNU.
9. IBEC Students who have completed required courses submit transcript of each semester, proof of English proficiency, and seminar hour records (the 2nd and 3rd items shall be issued within 2 years before the application date) to the responsible departments for verification before applying for programme certificate issued by the Office of Academic Affairs. Afterwards, Students may submit programme certificate, application form, Teacher Certificate and degree certificate to the responsible departments, the responsible departments will submit the list of Students who are qualified for IBCTL to the Office. The Office will then advise the IB about which Students have been successful. The Students then need to apply to the IB to receive their IBCTL. Please note that there is a fee payable to the IB. IEP Students have to submit additional self-exploration essay. Please note that, to apply for IBCTL, IEP

Students are required to have bachelor's or above degree and CLEP students are required to have master's or above degree.

10. Fees of this Programme shall be conducted abide by NTNU Student Charge Standard of each degree system.

11. As for any other matter which are not stated in this Regulation , but are covered in other regulations in NTNU, such regulations shall apply.

12. The Regulation shall be implemented upon approval by NTNU Faculty Council, and the same shall apply as to amendments hereto.
